## **Competition Rules**

Sanctioned as an Age Group Swimming Invitational by Swim Ontario.

All current Swimming Canada rules will be followed.

All swimmers are permitted to race with the swimwear of their choosing at all competitions sanctioned by Swim Ontario provided the fabric of the swimwear is a permeable open mesh textile and would not reasonably be seen to create a technical advantage in terms of speed, buoyancy, or endurance.

AGE UP DATE:	The competitor's age is as the first day of the competition – June 20, 2025			
DIVE STARTS:	As per the Facility Rules for Dive Starts, this competition Starts will be conducted as follows:  A. from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per World Aquatics II.4.1 and II.16.1.4 from the deep end only

## **Eligibility**

All athletes must be registered as <u>Competitive</u> swimmers with Swimming Canada and possess a valid Swimming Canada registration number. Entries submitted without a valid registration number and active status in the Swimming Canada Registration and Event Management System (REMS) at the time of the competition will be denied entry. It is the responsibility of the swimmer's club to provide proof of active registration status in REMS.

<b>COACH &amp; SUPPORT</b>
STAFF
REGISTRATION:

Meet management will cross reference the **list of coaches submitted with entries** at this competition with the <u>Swim Ontario Compliance lists</u>. If a coach is not on this list, meet management is obligated to enforce the Swimming Canada policy and not permit that coach to attend the meet. Meet management will forward Swim Ontario a list of coaches who they have found to be in non-compliance.

Swimmers must have a coach or designated coach (coach representative) in attendance during the meet including warm-up sessions.

Clubs needing Support Staff for Para or d/Deaf/Hard of Hearing swimmers must register them in the Swimming Canada Registration and Event Management System (REMS) to access the deck at competitions. Support Staff must have active REMS registration and be included in the club's event entry. Those not listed in the entry submission will be denied deck access.

# FOREIGN TEAMS / COMPETITORS:

The following applies to Teams and their competitors not affiliated with Swimming Canada. Swimmers registered as active with a Swimming Canada ID are considered domestic.

A. Foreign Teams' / competitors' entries will not be accepted by the host club.

# **Meet Format & Administration**

MIXED-	
GENDER:	An exemption from the requirement to swim events in gender separated events due to limited time, developmental opportunities or facility requirements and/or due to a missed swim, where on an exception basis, a referee agrees to have the swimmer swim with a heat of an opposite gender event.
	In spite of these exemptions, any swimmer who achieves a record time at a competition that recognizes records at any level (regional, provincial, national etc, whether age group or open) will not be recognized for that record unless the coach has advised the referee prior to the start of the session that there is a possibility of the record being broken, and the referee ensures that the swimmer competes with competitors of the same gender for his/her heat. In the event that mixed gender swims are permitted; the results must still be posted separately by gender of swimmers.
SEEDING:	After all times are converted as pursuant to the conversion process:  A. Seeding will be in order of entry times, slowest to fastest.
DECK ENTRIES:	All accepted Deck Entries are Exhibition Only and are not eligible for scoring or awards. No new heats will be created for deck entries (only empty lanes, if available). The following are the Deck Entry Rules for this competition:
	A. Swimmer Deck entries are permitted provided proof of active registration status with
	valid Swimming Canada ID is provided to Meet Management.
	B. Fee: \$20 CASH or etransfer to treasurer@burlingtondevilrays.ca
SCRATCHES:	The following are the Scratch deadlines for this competition.
	A. There is no scratch deadline for any event but scratches are appreciated and should be
	. made at the Admin Desk 30 minutes before the start of each session.
PENALTIES:	No penalty shall be imposed for late or day of scratches and No-Shows
OFFICIAL SPLIT TIMES:	Meet management requires that any coach wishing to rely on a time achieved by the swimmer for an interval shorter than the total distance of the event shall so advise the Referee at least 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the session in which the event will take place.  A. Official Split Forms are available at the Admin Desk.  B. Not all Official Split requests can be accommodated.
RECORDS:	Swim times achieved at this competition will NOT be used for applications of provincial and national records.

	Sprint lanes will be available for the last 15 minutes of warm-ups. Lanes 4-8 will be used for sprinting and are designated as diving lanes with one-way traffic only.

Volunteers may be stationed at the facility entrance to count the number of spectators. Meet Management may be required to implement a wristband policy if deck capacity becomes an issue. Any incidents of bullying or harassment may result in the removal of the spectator and/or their swimmer from the facility.

	<ul> <li>□ Teams are welcome to bring and set up two sun shelters per team on the grassy area on the south end of the pool as designated by Meet Management. Size of shelter should be limited to 10' x 10' and one per team. No shelters shall be set up on the deck.</li> <li>□ See Appendix B for a facility layout.</li> </ul>





Nelson Pool-Nelson Park, Burlington, Ontario


#### Layout for 2025 June Invitational

Parking is available at the pool; priority will be given to meet management and coaches for these spaces. Please be considerate of others and provide ample room to get people and cars in and out. There are several lots around the pool that are free. On street parking is at your own risk.

Should no parking spaces be available in the parking lots at Nelson Recreation Center, Nelson Park (north lot), or north of Nelson Stadium. Burlington street parking by-laws allow for personal vehicles to be parked in legally permitted areas for no more than 5 hours. By-law enforcement has been advised of the event and will be proactively patrolling the area to ensure compliance.

There are no lockers at Nelson Pool. There will be a set of bleachers on the Northeast side of the pool deck for spectators. Parents are encouraged to bring lawn chairs for seating.
